Thrift Shop an all-volunteer operation

The UCHC Auxiliary made the decision to return the Park Road Thrift Shop back to an all-volunteer shop, as the shop was not financially able to cover all expenses and two paid managers. The assistant manager position was eliminated in January and a new business plan was proposed by the board. The evaluation at the end of the 2011-2012 budget year (June 30, 2012) showed that we could not support any paid positions as we were in arrears, so the difficult decision was made that we would return to an allvolunteer staff. We did not want to close the Thrift Shop, as we have been at this location for over 19 vears.

We then closed for two weeks in August, reopening on Sept. 5 with a





new direction and reorganized store. We have been open for nearly three months under the all-volunteer program and we are progressing well. We have added new volunteers and have seen nice growth in our business and donations.

We have reinstituted a monthly pick-up at the Health Center, the last Monday of each month, and it has gone extremely well. We are not having November or December pickups because of the holidays, but will resume Jan. 28.

We wanted to inform the membership that the Thrift Shop is alive and well and hope to see you all there, remember that we are only six miles from UCHC and opened 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., Wednesday through Saturday.
