## Celeste LeWitt Gallery at UConn Health

At UConn Health, art is a core element of our therapeutic environment, conducive to healing, inspiration, and upliftment. Our art collection has over 2500 works of art, spanning across multiple genres and media.

In addition, UConn Health supports the local art community by exhibiting the work of regional artists in the Celeste LeWitt Gallery. Named for the founder of our art program, Celeste LeWitt, the gallery is located in our dining area, where patients, staff, and students visit daily. Two artists are featured each quarter, and we host a shared reception for them. Artists may sell their work without commission.

At the end of the show, artists often donate a work of art to our collection. Although encouraged, art donations are not a requirement for exhibiting.





As a public institution, exhibits in Celeste LeWitt Gallery shall not include imagery containing religious, political, violent, or nude content. Only two -dimensional art can be exhibited in the gallery. All works must be ready to hang, including appropriate hardware for installation.

We are currently scheduling for November 2024 and beyond.
