## **Artist biography**

Italo Valenti born 1912 [- 1995]

Italian painter and <u>collagist</u>, born in Milan. Studied at the Brera <u>Academy</u> in Milan 1932-7, then took an active part in the movement Corrente with Cassinari, Birolli, Fontana, Santomaso and others. Made <u>paintings</u> based on a childhood world of fable and enchantment, with marvellous fairy-tale gardens, fantastic animals, etc., in glowing radiant colours. First one-man exhibition at the Galleria di Corrente, Milan, 1941. His work later became less exuberant and less colourful, especially after his move to Switzerland, near Locarno, in 1953; gradually developed in the second half of the 1950s an <u>abstract</u>, <u>tachiste</u> style, and started in 1959 to make abstract collages out of cut and torn <u>paper</u>. Friendship with Julius Bissier and Ben Nicholson, who lived nearby. Lives at Ascona.

He was an avid painter and teacher, after a stroke he called this period, the era of the left hand. Italio died in Ascona on 6th September 1995.
