Lila Scott Brewer, age 96, of Upper Arlington, died Thursday, (January 21, 2010) at First Community Village Healthcare Center. She was born January 9, 1914, in Brush, CO, a daughter of Aaron and Edith (Fuller) Scott and spent most of her childhood in southwestern Pennsylvania. Lila completed her nurse's training at Washington Hospital in Washington, PA, where she earned an R.N degree. The family moved to Long Island, NY, in1948, when her husband Mel joined the fund raising firm of Marts and Lundy, Inc.. With later moves to West Hartford and Stamford, CT, she studied art in Stamford and Simsbury with private teachers and at the University of Hartford. She was named a juried member of the Connecticut Women Artists in New Haven.

Lila Brewer had studied painting and collage with private instructors in Stamford, West Hartford and the Farmington Valley. She had participated in various workshops in the area and had also studied at the Hartford Art School. She was a juried member of the Canton Artists' Guild and Connecticut Women Artists.

Her work has been exhibited in juried shows at the Stamford Art Association, the Stamford Museum and Nature Center, the Art Society of Old Greenwich, New haven Paint and Clay, Wintonbury Art Association and the Beth El Spring Show. She had participated in group shows throughout Connecticut, as well as in Connecticut Women Artist juried shows.

The artist was a former board member of the Stamford Art Association, and formerly a board member of Avon arts and Crafts Association, having served as chair of the Scholarship Committee which annually selects two Valley High School seniors as recipients of scholarships for further study in the arts.
