REDCap and the NIH Data Archive (NDA)

The National Institutes of Health (NIH) [Data Management and Sharing \(DMS\) Policy](#) - mandating the submission of data management plans (DMSPs) with grant proposals and the sharing of the project's scientific data - went into effect on January 25, 2023. This policy applies to all research, that is funded or conducted in whole or in part by the NIH, and results in the generation of scientific data.

So what does that mean if the research project you're working on has a data sharing and archiving requirement?
