

Her talks, essays and stories illuminate lifetime consequences of childhood trauma, harmful effects of fads in psychiatric diagnosis and treatment, the enduring impact of stigma and shame, and the power of human connection to heal. Directions to UConn Health, Conference Room EG013

Take I-84 to Exit 39. Turn right onto Route 4 East (Farmington Avenue). Drive about 1 1/2 miles and turn right into UConn Health. Entering from Farmington Avenue, proceed to the roundabout and follow the signs to the Academic Entrance. Bear right at the fork and continue up the hill. At the stop sign turn left into the Academic Entrance and park in lot AB on your right. Park at the end of the lot, take the stairs, and someone will open the door at 5 p.m. (cell: 860-836-3966 or 860-324-3691). Parking is unrestricted after 5 p.m. and on Saturday and Sunday.

Alternatively, or after 5:15 p.m., enter through the Academic Entrance, turn right, and follow the hallway passed the Police Department. Enter the EG floor. They'll be an elevator on your left over looking glass doors. Conference room EG013 is on your right. (cell: 860-836-3966 or 860-324-3691)
