HOW CAN I PARTICIPATE IN A VIRTUAL PLATFORM?

Unlike an in-person conference, participants are encouraged to "ask" questions of presenters and share insights on topics through the use of the Zoom "chat" tool. A volunteer moderator has been assigned to each session and he/she will alert presenters to questions in the chat. We know that all participants will pose questions in a collegial and civil manner.

HOW DO I SELECT A BREAKOUT SESSION?

Following the Zoom guidance provided in your registration confirmation email, participants can "move" themselves to different breakout rooms. This requires having the most current Zoom download (5.4.4) and clicking on the icon at the bottom of the screen that says "breakout room".
