UConn School of Nursing Urban Service Track/AHEC Scholars Get Creative in the UConn Innovation Zone Makerspace

Nursing students in the Urban Service Track/AHEC scholar program spent their last on-campus meeting creating t-shirts in UConn's Innovation Zone Makerspace. The staff instructed them on how to design and print the Urban Service Track and nursing school logos onto their t-shirts. There are currently fourteen nursing students in the program, six will be graduating this year.

The Urban Service Track/AHEC Scholars program is a two-year, curriculum focused on educating students on underserved urban and rural communities. Participants represent a select group of students enrolled in the UConn Schools of Pharmacy, Nursing, Medicine, Dental Medicine, Social Work, and Quinnipiac University's Physician Assistant Program. The program is part of a national movement funded by the U.S. Bureau of Health Workforce focused on training health professions students to provide care to vulnerable underserved communities.
