

## **USMLE 3/COMLEX 3**

All PGY 1 residents must take USMLE 3/COMLEX 3 before the end of the PGY1 year.

If a resident enters a University of Connecticut School of Medicine residency program as a PGY 2 and has not taken and passed USMLE 3/COMLEX 3, the resident must take USMLE 3/COMLEX 3 within the first 6 months of the PGY 2 year. The resident must pass USMLE 3/COMLEX 3 by the end of the PGY2 year.

Successful completion of USMLE 3/COMLEX 3 is a requirement to be promoted or appointed to the PGY 3 or above training level.

Residents seeking to enter a University of Connecticut School of Medicine residency program as a PGY 3 must have taken and passed USMLE 3/COMLEX 3. Fellows seeking to enter a University of Connecticut School of Medicine fellowship program must have taken and passed USMLE 3/COMLEX 3.
