INTERNATIONAL CITIZEN EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENT

All residents/fellows must be eligible for employment to participate in any Graduate Medical Education sponsored program. If a resident/fellow is an international citizen and wants employment at a University of Connecticut School of Medicine (UConn) sponsored program, UConn, as the sponsoring institution, only supports the clinical (ECF MG sponsored) J - 1 Visa. Residents/fellows with a valid Employment Authorization Document (EAD) issued by the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) are also eligible. The University of Connecticut School of Medicine Graduate Medical Education programs and the Capital Area Health Consortium do not sponsor H - 1B visas under any circumstances.
