TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

Residents/fellows transferring into a residency/fellowship program at The University of Connecticut School of Medicine (UConn SOM) from another program must meet the requirements outlined in the Eligibility Requirements Policy and the Appointment/Contract Requirements Policy. Before accepting a resident/fellow who is transferring from another program, the UConn SOM Program Director and Graduate Medical Education (GME) Office must obtain written or electronic verification of all United States/Canadian previous educational experiences and a summative competency-based performance evaluation of the transferring resident/fellow. A form is available from the GME Office.

A Resident/fellow transferring out of a residency/fellowship program sponsored by UConn SOM must notify their Program Director in a timely manner. The Program Director must provide verification of the resident's/fellow's status in the program and complete a summative performance evaluation for the resident/fellow and the next Program Director. The resident/fellow must also meet the last 4 requirements outlined in the Graduation/Separation Requirements Policy. These include:

Must complete all program exit requirements
Must complete an exit survey
Must attend an exit interview and complete the sign-out sheet with the Capital Area Health
Consortium (exception: a resident/fellow who changes programs does not need to attend
the exit interview or complete the sign-out sheet until the completion of his/her last
program at UConn SOM)
Must meet with the Program Director or designee to review and sign the final verification of
training

Failure to comply with these requirements may result in administrative consequences.
