





	ACADEMIC POLICY <i>Supervision Policy</i>
A. EFFECTIVE DATE :	4/19
B. PURPOSE :	This policy outlines the minimum institutional standards for supervision of residents/fellows in their provision of patient care.
C. POLICY :	<p>Each patient must have an identifiable, appropriately credentialed attending physician or licensed independent practitioner who is responsible and accountable for the patient’s care.</p> <p>All patient care performed by residents during training will be under the supervision of a physician faculty member, a licensed provider, fellow, or a more senior resident, either on site, or by means of telephonic and/or electronic modalities. Some activities require the physical presence of the supervising faculty member.</p>
D. SCOPE :	Residents and Fellows
E. PROCEDURES, GUIDELINES AND PROTOCOLS :	<p>Supervision in the setting of graduate medical education provides safe and effective care to patients; ensures each resident/fellow’s development of the skills, knowledge, and attitudes required to enter the unsupervised practice of medicine; and establishes a foundation for continued professional growth.</p> <p>Please refer to the Supervision, Progressive Authority and Responsibility of Residents/Fellows guidelines and procedures set forth in this policy.</p> <p>See John Dempsey Hospital Medical Staff Bylaws</p>
