Injuries for Occupational Health	Injuries for Emergency Department
	(during and after hours)
 Needlesticks, eye splashes with bodily 	Needlesticks after hours
fluids	Toxic chemical exposures
 Minor cuts with controlled bleeding (no sutures needed) 	 Eye injury or exposure to toxic chemicals (acid/base)
 Sprains and strains 	Large lacerations requiring repair
 Low back injuries (not significant 	Orthopedic fracture or dislocation
trauma)	
 Repetitive stress injuries 	

- Seek treatment at the facility where you are injured. If working at CCMC, seek treatment at HH.
- DO NOT PROVIDE YOUR INSURANCE CARE EVEN IF YOU ARE ASKED FOR IT. Make sure you are not listed as the guarantor, resulting in a personal financial obligation; list (CAHC as the guarantor).
- Call CAHC to report your injury (860) 676-1110 within 24 hours. If after hours, please leave a general voicemail with your name, contact number, and the specifics of your injury.
- Please notify CAHC immediately on all billing errors.
