Molly Brewer, DVM, MD, MS, is a nationally recognized gynecologic oncologist. Dr. Brewer formerly practiced at the UT MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston and the Arizona Cancer Center at the University of Arizona in Tucson, where she was the director of the cancer center's gynecologic oncology division.

Dr. Brewer earned her medical degree from the College of Medicine at the State University of New York at Syracuse and completed her residency at Oregon Health Sciences in Portland. She completed her fellowship at the UT M.D.

Anderson Cancer Center in Houston. Dr. Brewer also holds a master's degree in statistical analysis and clinical research design from the University of Michigan School of Public Health in Ann Arbor.
