“(Dis)solving the Unknown in Pediatric Kidney Stone Disease”

Sherene Mason, M.D., MBA is an Attending Physician of Pediatric Nephrology at Connecticut Children's Medical Center with appointment as Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at the University Of Connecticut School of Medicine. She completed her pediatric residency, chief resident year, and nephrology fellowship at Yale University School of Medicine. During her fellowship Dr. Mason completed research examining pathways important in renal tubular repair following renal injury. She was awarded the American Society of Pediatric Nephrology Fellow's Research Award

in Basic Science and has published manuscripts on her work. Dr. Mason has a strong interest in pediatric stone disease, congenital abnormalities of the kidney and urinary tract, mechanisms underlying acute and chronic kidney disease and renal transplantation. She is an active member of the American Society of Pediatric Nephrology, the American Academy of Pediatrics and the American Society of Nephrology. Dr. Mason is devoted to excellence in medical student and resident trainee education in addition to demonstrating excellence in patient care and research.
