“Sclerostin, Bone and Osteoporosis”

Dr. Mirza is an Assistant Professor of Medicine in the Division of Endocrinology and Metabolism at the University of Connecticut Health Center. She specializes in the management of patients with osteoporosis and other women's health issues. Dr. Mirza had completed her internship of Internal Medicine at Grant Hospital of Chicago and her residency in Internal Medicine at Westlake Community Hospital. After completing her residency in Internal Medicine, she worked as a Primary Care Physician for six years at Lee County

Community Hospital, Pennington Gap, Virginia. Dr. Mirza then pursued fellowships in Hypertension/Endocrinology at Harvard Medical School and in Endocrinology and Women's Health at the University of Connecticut School of Medicine. Her research interests include osteoporosis, gender biology and physiological changes that occur with menopause. Dr. Mirza's clinical experience and training provide her with special insight into women's health problems.
