Suzanne Rose, M.D., M.S.Ed.

Professor of Medicine, University of Connecticut School of Medicine

“Networking: Navigating the Necessities”

In 2011, Dr. Rose was appointed the Senior Associate Dean for Education at the University of Connecticut School of Medicine. Prior to UConn, she served for thirteen years at Mount Sinai School of Medicine in various leadership capacities including associate dean for academic and student affairs, associate dean for continuing medical education and vice chair for faculty affairs. She previously held positions at Cornell University Medical College in New York City (1996-1997) as the director of motility and the second-year pathophysiology course. She also was on faculty at the University of Pittsburgh from 1990 to

1996, where she ran the second-year GI course. She directed the gastroenterology (GI) fellowship program at both Pittsburgh and Cornell.

Among her many goals for the UConn School of Medicine are: continuing the excellence the school has reached academically; fostering enhanced collaborations between students and faculty; promoting inter-professional training; pursuing ongoing technological advances; and supporting career development avenues for all learners and faculty.
