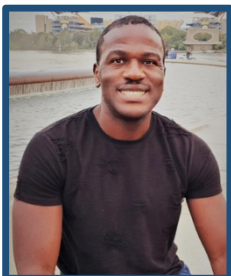

Kristen Glasgow, M.D., grew up in North Salem, New York and matriculated to Wesleyan University. From there Dr. Glasgow graduated with a degree in biology and spent a year doing research at the Columbia College of Physicians and Surgeons. She then was accepted to the University of Connecticut School of Medicine where she graduated in 2009. It was there that Dr. Glasgow developed her interest in surgery and matched to the St. Raphael’s Surgery Residency Program and finished at the Yale New Haven Hospital Surgical Residency. She then went to the University of Texas Medical Branch and Shriners Hospital where she spent a year learning burn surgery and critical care, and is currently double boarded in general surgery and critical care. For the past 6 years Dr. Glasgow has been working as an Acute Care Surgeon at Bridgeport Hospital covering trauma, general surgery, burn surgery and critical care. She is also Surgeon Champion for the National Surgical Quality Improvement Program (NSQIP) and is active in teaching both medical students from SABA University and surgical residents from Yale New Haven Hospital.



Johnny Joseph, D.M.D., is a Board Certified Pediatric Dentist. He is currently practicing in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Dr. Joseph is owner of Pediatric Dentistry Asleep P.C. a subspecialty pediatric dental office limited to complete pediatric oral rehabilitation under general anesthesia. Dr. Joseph is also a faculty member at the University of Pittsburgh Children’s Hospital and the University of the West Indies. He was born in Kinshasas, RD Congo. Dr. Joseph graduated from Stonehill College in Massachusetts, received his Doctor of Dental Medicine degree from the University of Connecticut School of Dental Medicine in 2018.
