**Emily Hogeland, MD**, is an attending physician in the Division of Hospital Medicine at Connecticut Children’s and Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at UConn School of Medicine. She attended Harvard College for undergraduate studies, and then spent a year in Bolivia learning about healthcare delivery for indigenous populations. She attended medical school at University of California - San Francisco and then completed her pediatrics residency at the University of Washington/Seattle Children’s - Alaska Track. After graduating from residency, she worked as a pediatric hospitalist at Alaska Native Medical Center in Anchorage for six years, where she had the privilege of caring for Alaska Native children and their families. She transitioned to Connecticut Children’s in 2022, where she is now involved in both graduate medical education as Associate Program Director for the UConn Pediatric Residency, as well as undergraduate medical education as Assistant Clerkship Director of the UConn inpatient pediatrics clerkship. She is passionate about healthcare for underserved populations, trauma-informed care, and cultural humility.
