

Presenter, Surita Rao, MBBS, MD, FASM, is an associate professor and director of the psychiatry residency program at UConn School of Medicine, specializing in addiction psychiatry. Her career spans clinical care, teaching, and leadership, including roles at Yale, Emory, Saint Francis Care, and Connecticut Valley Hospital. She has worked extensively with impaired healthcare professionals and led methadone treatment programs. Dr. Rao serves on the Board of Directors for the American Society of Addiction Medicine and has presented nationally on psychiatry and addiction. Her media appearances include CNN and the radio show Mental Health with Dr. Surita Rao.
