Kristen Glasgow, M.D. grew up in North Salem, New York and matriculated to Wesleyan University in 2000. Prior to starting her undergraduate career, Dr. Glasgow participated in the Aetna Health Professions Partnership Initiative Pre College Program the summer of 2000. She then participated in the Wesleyan University Clinical College Enrichment Program at Connecticut Valley Hospital the summer of 2001, the Summer Research Fellowship Program the summer of 2002, and the Medical/Dental Preparatory Program the summer of 2003. Dr. Glasgow graduated with a degree in biology May of 2004 and spent a year after doing research at the Columbia College of Physicians and Surgeons. She then matriculated to the University of Connecticut School of Medicine where she received her medical degree May 2009. At UConn, Dr. Glasgow developed her interest in surgery and matched at the Hospital of Saint Raphael Surgery Residency Program and finished at the Yale New Haven Hospital Surgical Residency.
