Dr. LeBeauf also has a Ph.D. in Counselor Education from the University of New Orleans. She is a former doctoral professor of Counseling at the University of Nevada, Reno, and has authored and co-authored numerous book chapters, peer-reviewed articles and national level presentations focusing on culturally competent mental health care.

As a newly minted medical doctor, Dr. LeBeauf began her residency training in anesthesiology later transitioning to psychiatry at the University of Connecticut.
