Dr. Iyanna Liles FACOG obtained her bachelor's degree from Duke University in 2010, her medical degree from Emory University School of Medicine in 2014 and completed her Obstetrics & Gynecology residency at the University of Connecticut in 2018. Currently she specializes in gynecologic care and minimally invasive surgery at Comprehensive GYN of CT a division of Women's Health CT and provides obstetric services at Saint Francis Hospital and Medical Center. She is also an Assistant Clinical Professor in Obstetrics & Gynecology at the Frank H. Netter MD School of Medicine at Quinnipiac University and at Yale University School of Medicine. She actively participates in the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology as the recent past District I Fellow Patient Safety and Quality Improvement Chair and currently is a member of the Government Affairs and Quality Safety Initiatives committees. Dr. Liles participated in several legislative sessions giving testimony and/or meeting with legislators regarding various women's health topics. She volunteers as a general OB/GYN physician with the Connecticut Maternal Mortality Review Committee providing feedback on ways to improve maternal care in the state and on the Advisory Committee for Advancing Maternal Health Equity in Connecticut. She is also a member of the Connecticut Reproductive Justice Alliance and membership chair for the Connecticut IMHOTEP National Medical Association.
