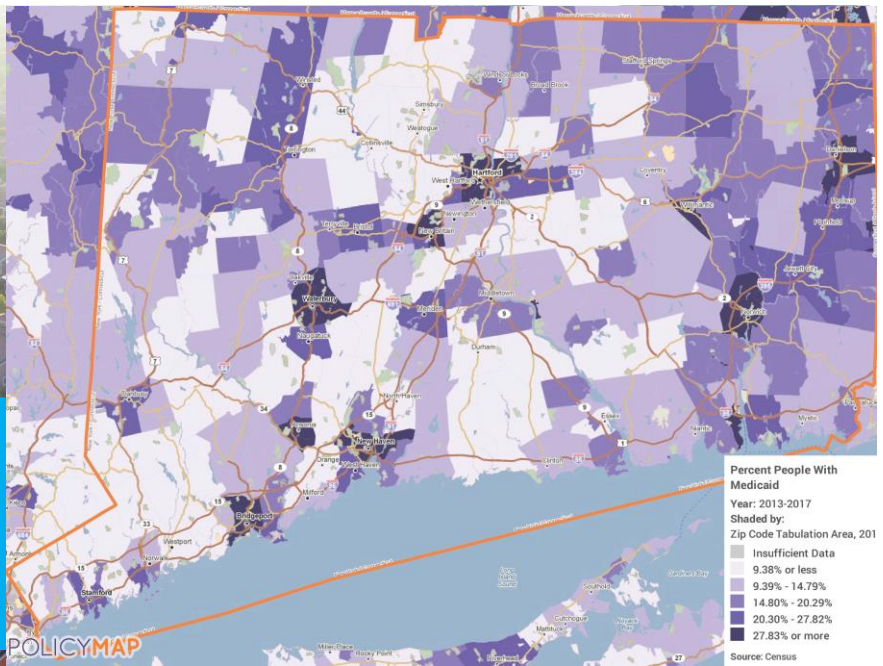

PolicyMap

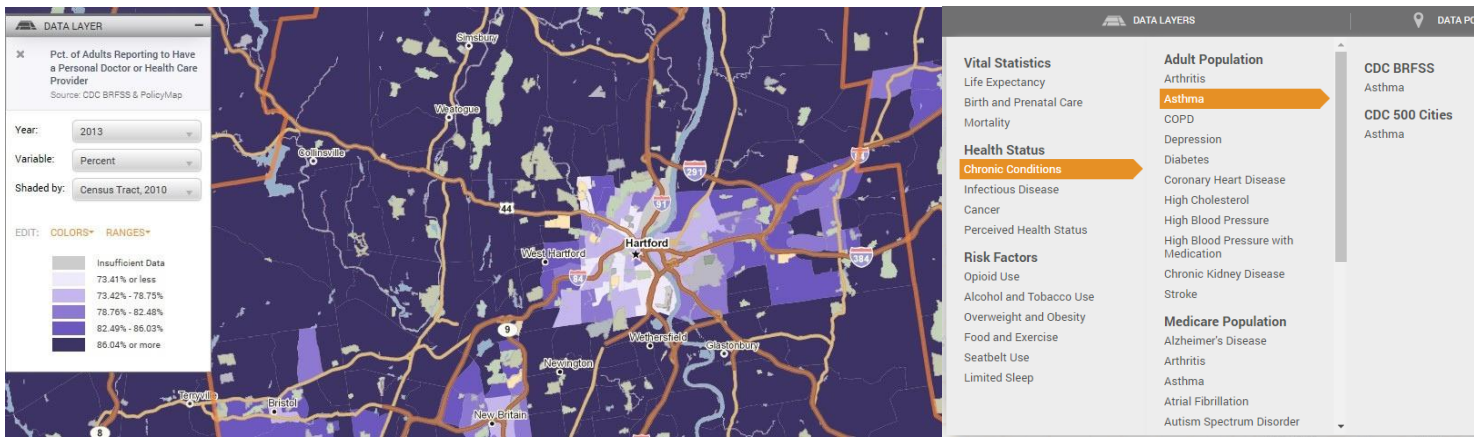
PolicyMap is a Big Data analytic interface – licensed by the Uconn Health Disparities Institute (HDI) – that offers mapping of data on health and well being indicators including demographics, real estate, health, jobs, and more in communities across Connecticut and the US.

What Can You Do With PolicyMap?

- Link, integrate, and triangulate layers of spatial, individual-level, and population-based data
- Create maps to visualize demographic information from the Census, as well as, unique third-party data
- Download data/upload your own address-level data
- Generate reports (i.e., community assessments, market reports)
- Conduct 'Hot spotting' analysis
 - Layer data maps- Find areas that meet up-to-three criteria for site selection or to find hot spots

PolicyMap Features

- Identify gaps in services by using maps of income, demographics, housing, education, health, and more.
- Create Community Health Reports by areas including healthcare access, health behaviors, outcomes, morbidity, mortality, food security, and social determinants of health.
- Upload locations of data such as facilities, surveys, and programs.
- Layer data based on criteria and visibly filter attributes on multiple indicators.
- Download data for research and design interventions to improve health in communities where you work, live, play, pray, and get health care.
- Locate partners and community assets.
- Leverage funding opportunities.
