UConn HDI is looking for student interns enrolled in a master's, Ph.D., or MD/Ph.D. and has experience or an interest in policy, research, writing, and health equity. A one-year commitment is preferred. There will be continued supervision and mentorship throughout the intern program. Student interns must commit to at least one semester, and:

- 1. Attend all weekly check-ins related to project updates
- 2. With preceptor, determine individual intern goals for the semester/year.
- 3. Complete an evaluation at the end of the semester.
- 4. Present project(s) worked on at the end of the internship.

The Health Equity internship includes, but is not limited to:

- Conducting policy research and landscape analysis.
- Assist in writing briefs and other educational resources on various issues, including education, mental health, behavioral health, healthcare, juvenile justice, and incarceration.
- Conducting literature reviews and assist with grant preparation
- Assisting with qualitative data analysis of health equity-focused in-depth interview and Delphi sessions transcripts.
- Attending relevant briefings and seminars, providing webinar support, assisting with grant preparation and partner meetings, data entry, attending alliance and partner meetings, and taking notes.
- Working on projects collaboratively and independently; presenting at meetings; learning from and collaborating with HDI's faculty, staff, and community stakeholders.
