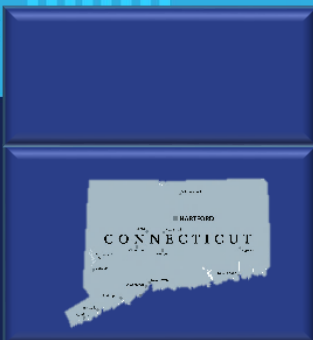

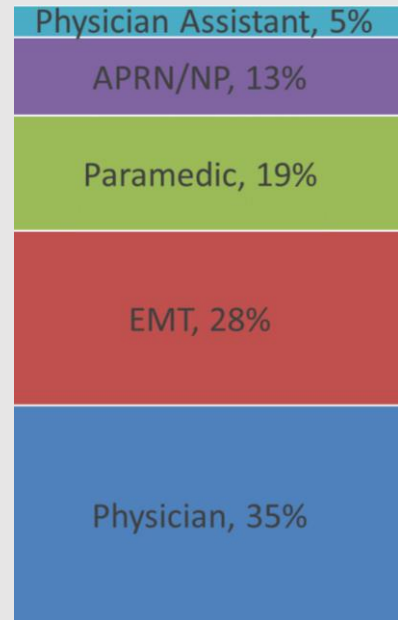

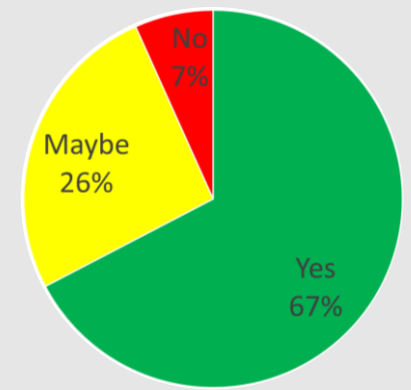


Advance Directive Survey (n=450)



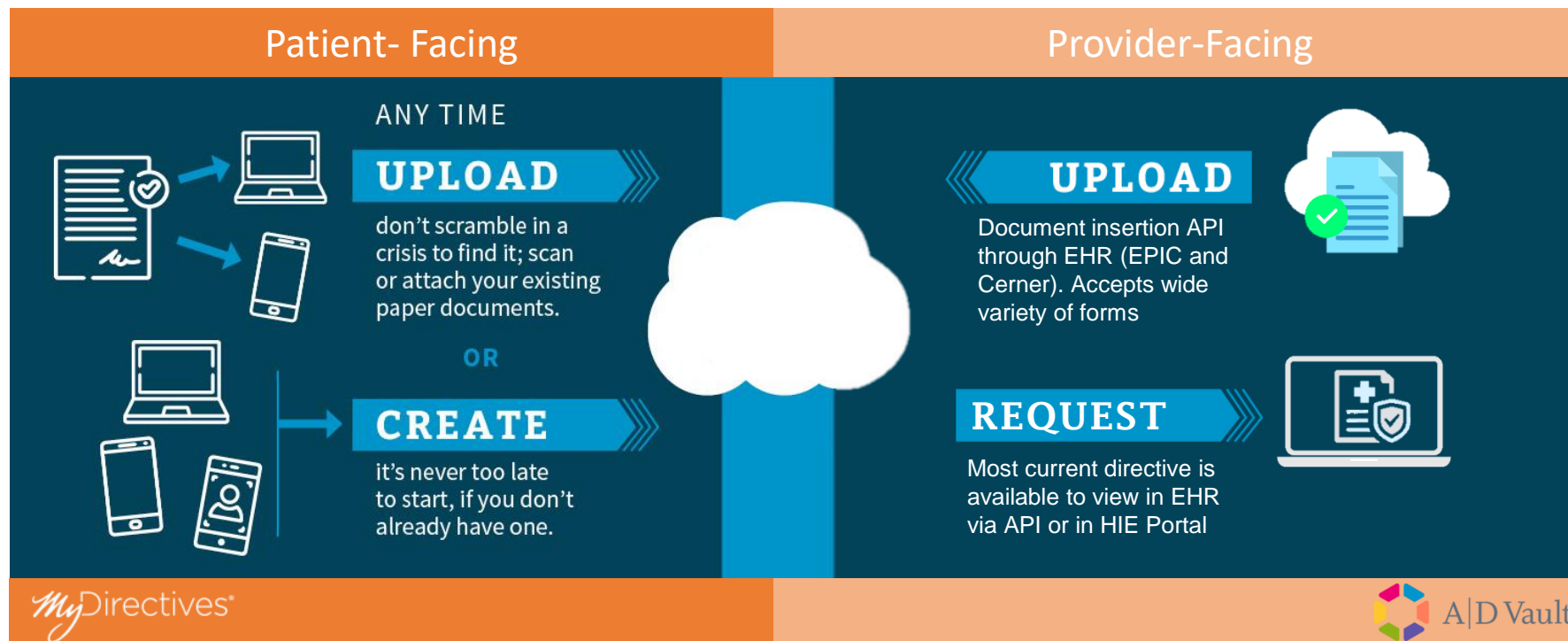

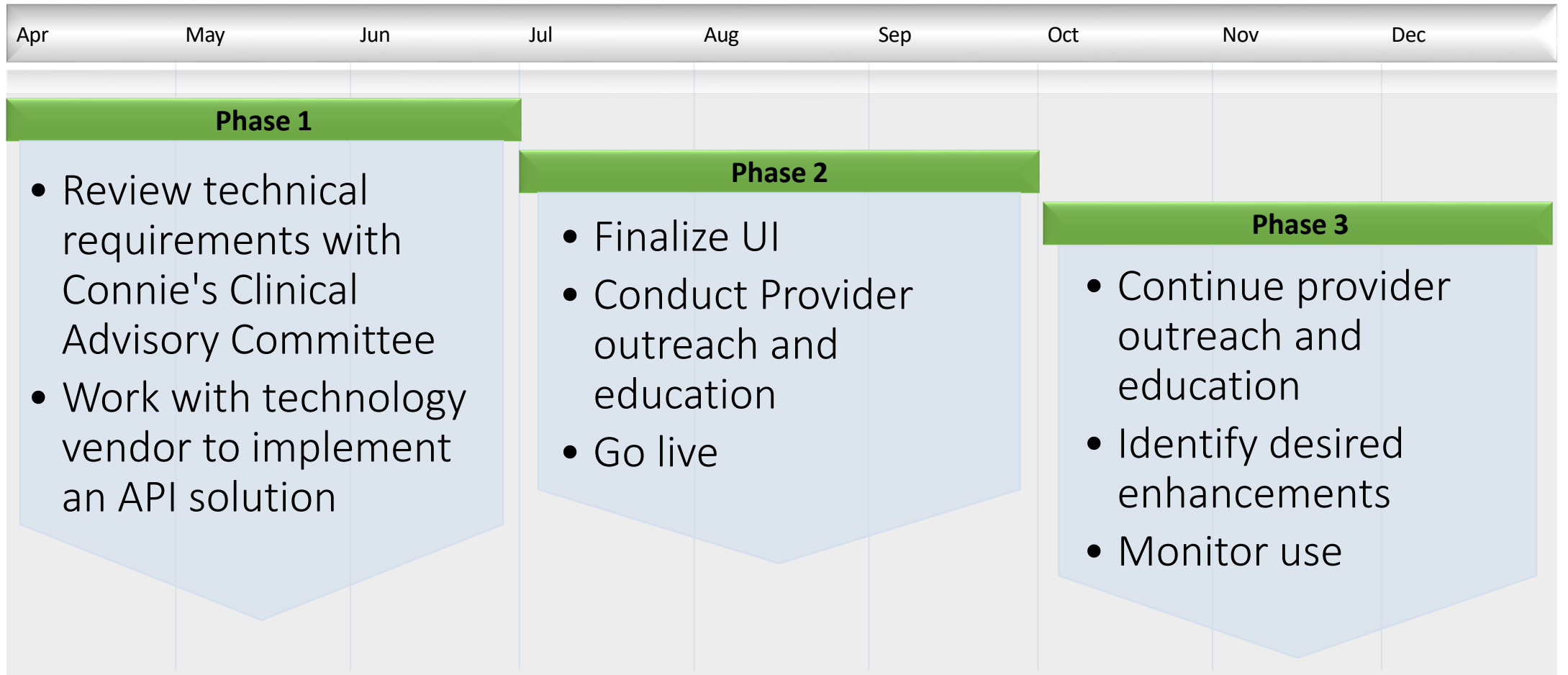

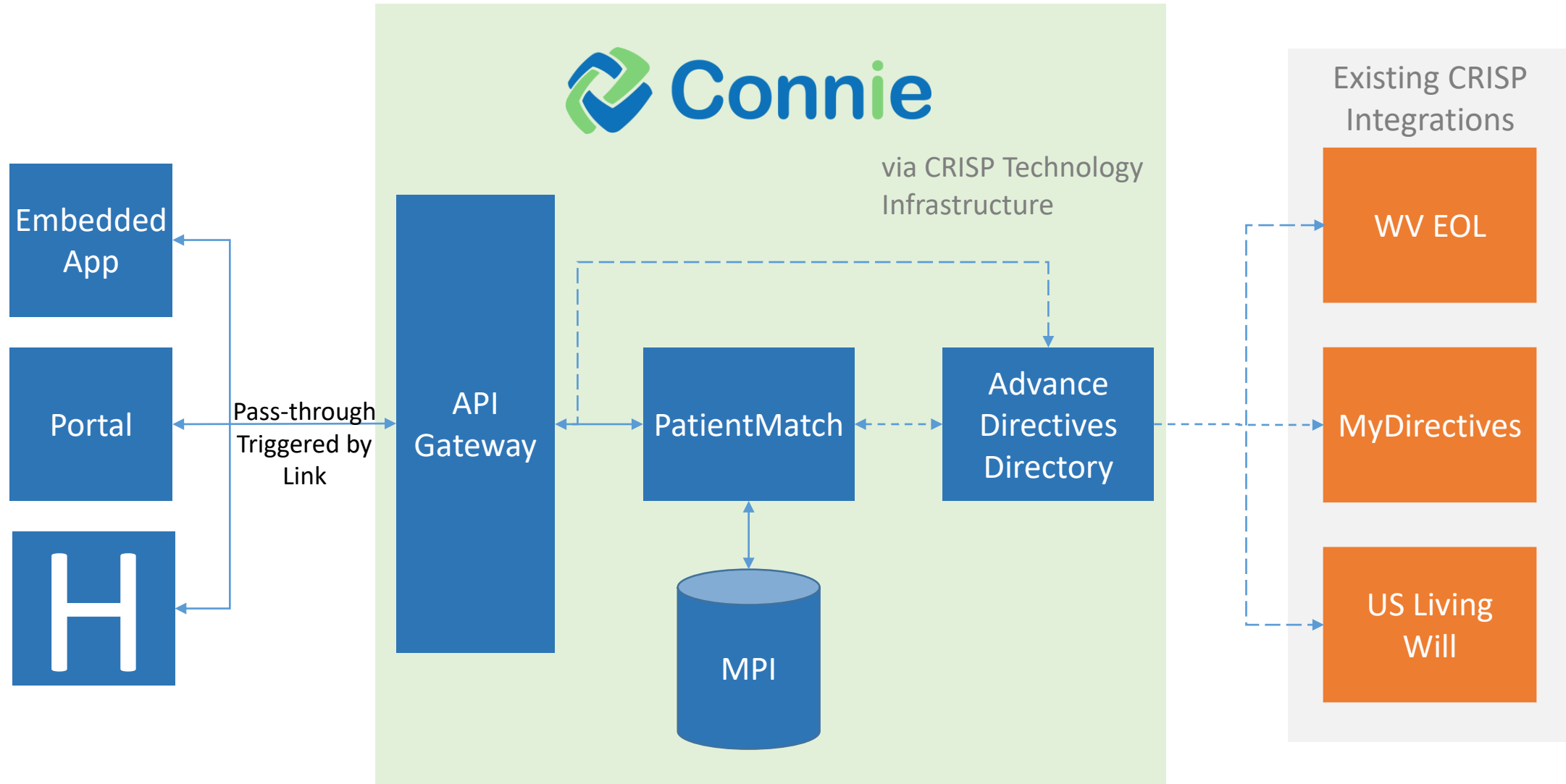
