## University Health Professionals (Salary)

This position is governed by the applicable provisions of the <u>University Health Professionals (UHP) Local 3837 collective</u> <u>bargaining agreement</u>. In accordance with the contract, you are eligible for:

- Leave Accruals
  - $\circ$  Vacation Leave: accrue .843 days per pay period (22 vacation days per year)\*
  - Sick Leave: accrue 4.64 hours per paid period (120 sick hours per year)\*
  - Personal Leave: 3 personal days\* granted upon hire. Then granted per year on the first day of the first full pay period of the employee's birth month. Expires annually. (Refer to UHP contract for schedule)
- Holidays: 13 observed holidays per year
- Tuition Program
  - Tuition Waiver: for UHP employees and their dependent children enrolled in an undergraduate degree program at the University of Connecticut and its regional campuses or reciprocal Universities.
  - o <u>Tuition Reimbursement Program</u>: for UHP employees enrolled in college or university courses in CT
- Negotiated salary increases
- Scholarship for childcare at the Creative Child Care Center

As a State of Connecticut Employee, you are eligible for the following:

- Health Care Options (available only for employees of 50% FTE or higher)
  - o <u>State Employee Medical Benefits</u>
  - o State Employee Dental Benefits
  - o <u>Prescription Drug Coverage</u>
- Retirement Benefits
