

Alaris Guardrails Library Updates

August 2021

Pharmacy has released an updated library for August 2021. Information below details what updates will occur and reminders after the release.



Reminders:

- New library name will be **UConn 8-10-2021** and will appear on display screen when powered up
- The pump must be powered down and up to obtain the latest release
- Don't forget to page down to access additional doses for Vancomycin (e.g. >1250mg)

Updates to Library include the following:

OP Cancer Center Profile

- Removal of etoposide phosphate
- Ipilimumab dosing units changed from mg to mg/kg and infusion duration separated by indication (melanoma vs non-melanoma)
- Sacituzumab govitecan added
- Bendamustine duration adjusted to allow 10 minute infusion and dosing changed from mg to mg/m²
- Pembrolizumab 400mg/100mL added; max dose increased to accommodate new dose
- Lurbinectedin added
- Hemin added

Oncology Profile

- Ipilimumab dosing units changed from mg to mg/kg and infusion duration separated by indication (melanoma vs non-melanoma)
- Pembrolizumab 400mg/100mL added; max dose increased to accommodate new dose

Investigational Profile

- New profile created for administration of investigational medications via syringe pump as part of a clinical trial

OP Infusion Center Profile

- Sotrovimab added
- Ocrelizumab maximum dose rate increased for shorter infusion time
- Casirivimab/imdevimab dose updated per EUA to 1200mg
