

Alaris Guardrails Library Updates September 2023

Pharmacy has released an updated library for September 2023. Information below details what updates will occur and reminders after the release.



Reminders:

- The pump must be powered down and up, and new patient selected to obtain the latest release
- Don't forget to page down to access additional doses for Vancomycin (e.g. >1250mg)

Additions:

- Polatuzumab to the *OP Cancer Center* Profile

Updates:

- Calcium Gluconate initial infusion time in the *Adult Critical Care, Med/Surg, OB/LD, Oncology, OP Cancer Center* and *OP Infusion Center* Profiles
- Multivitamin infusion changed to standard concentration with clarifying clinical advisory in the *Adult Critical Care, Med/Surg, OB/LD, Oncology* Profiles
- Clinical Advisory updates to align with hospital High Alert & Look-Alike, Sound-Alike policies:
 - Alteplase infusions
 - Oxytocin cont infusions
 - Morphine cont infusions and PCA entries all concentrations
 - Hydromorphone conts infusions and PCA entries all concentrations
 - Fentanyl cont infusion in the *Anesthesia, and Med/Surg* Profiles
 - Remifentanyl cont infusion in the *Anesthesia* Profile
 - Amphotericin B (lipid formulation) in the *OP Cancer Center* Profile
 - Cisplatin in the *Oncology* and *OP Cancer Center* Profiles
 - Carboplatin in the *Oncology* and *OP Cancer Center* Profiles
 - Doxorubicin all formulations in the *Oncology* and *OP Cancer Center* Profiles
 - Dextrose 10% in all Profiles fluid libraries
 - Epinephrine in *Adult Critical Care* and *Anesthesia* Profiles
