POLICY: PERMANENT RESIDENCY PETITIONS

Federal law authorizes UConn Health to sponsor permanent residency petitions for individuals in full time positions, subject to those petitions' meeting federal guidelines. In general, UConn Health will sponsor such petitions for permanent faculty positions only.

Any requests for exceptions to this policy must be made in writing to the Executive Vice President, Vice President of Research or Provost, and the appropriate Dean (or their designees) of UConn Health and demonstrate extraordinary circumstances where sponsorship of the permanent residency petition demonstrates clear benefit to UConn Health.

PROCEDURES:

Departments who wish to sponsor a faculty member for permanent residency must review available funding levels for the position and provide substantiation of this funding along with the application for review by the Executive Vice President, Vice President of Research or Provost, and the appropriate Dean (or their designees).
