



CLINICAL STANDING ORDER
For Antepartum Testing with Amniotic Fluid Assessment or
Biophysical Profile

1. EFFECTIVE DATE:	September 9, 2020
2. PURPOSE	To establish guidelines for ordering Amniotic Fluid Assessment (AFA) or Biophysical Profile (BPP) when indicated during a scheduled visit for antepartum testing.
3. STANDING ORDER	Enter ultrasound order for AFA or BPP based on physician interpretation of NST.
4. SCOPE	UMG Women's Health and Maternal Fetal Medicine ambulatory practice
5. AUTHORIZED USERS	Registered Nurses
6. CRITERIA	Based on physician interpretation of NST and Clinical Algorithm for Antepartum Testing, RN may initiate order for appropriate ultrasound testing (AFA or BPP) if indicated for results of: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. One time NST(not routine)Or2. Routine NST 2 times per week starting at 28 or 32 weeks gestation
7. MATERIALS NEEDED	None
8. PROCEDURE	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. NST is scheduled in EPIC (standing or one-time order)2. NST performed by RN3. Physician (MD/DO) interprets NST (Reactive or Non-Reactive)<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. If reactive and due for AFA, RN places order for US for AFAb. If reactive and NOT due for AFA, and no other indication for AFA, no US order is placedc. If non-reactive RN places order for US for BPP; if BPP is performed, do not need separate AFA as it is part of the BPP4. NST documentation and transcription of NST interpretation by physician is documented in OB Tools NST flowsheet in EPIC5. RN checks appropriate billing code in OB Tools NST flowsheet in EPIC6. RN sends note to responsible provider for cosign
