


Coronal T1-Gd







Neurosarcoidosis

- Age peak: Typically occurring between 20 and 40 years of age
- Pathology: Granulomatous inflammation
- Locations: Commonly involves hypothalamus, pituitary, and optic chiasm
- Symptoms: Facial nerve palsy, optic neuropathy & diabetes insipidus are common
