If you completed a FAFSA last academic year, review and update all of your information as needed. **Parental information for students applying for university funding must be included on the FAFSA unless they have children of their own.**

UConn Student 2018 FAFSA Statement

"UConn Student 2018 FAFSA Statement" is a form that you must complete and submit to the Office of Financial Aid Services. It is used to determine your eligibility for federal financial aid. You must complete this form even if you are not applying for federal financial aid. You must have a parent sign this form. If you are a non-tax filer, you must complete a Non-Tax Filer Statement.
